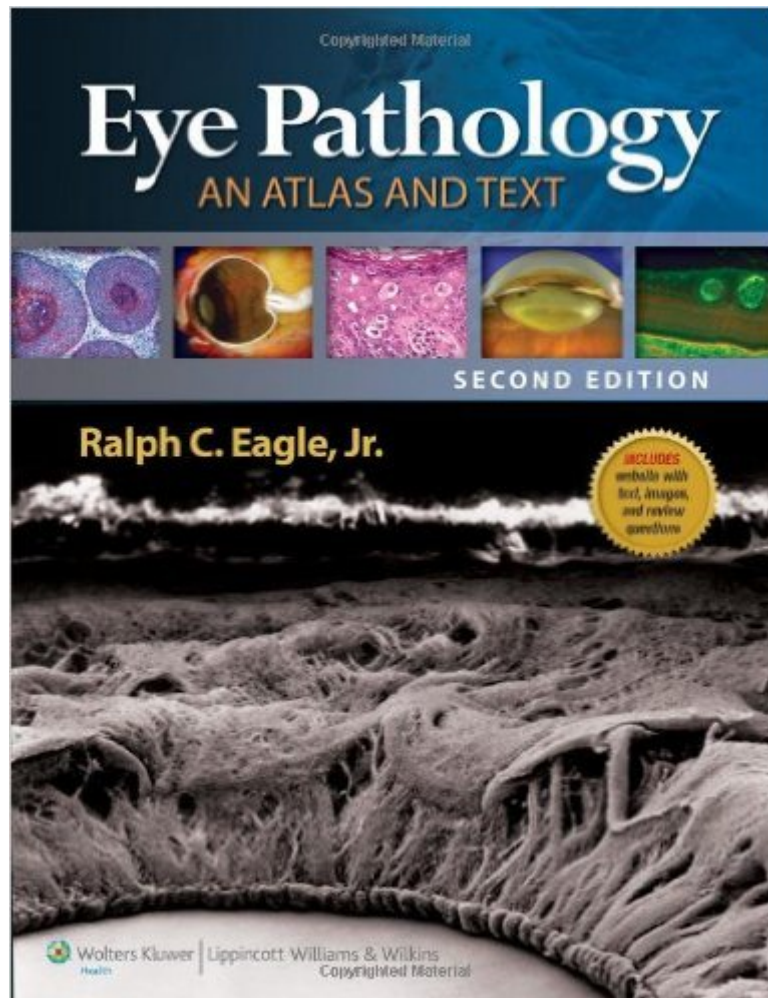


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Eye Pathology: An Atlas And Text

The text is well written and includes a helpful list of detailed references at the end of each chapter. The ability to access the book online to download pictures from an image bank and take an interactive test (over 400 questions) on the subject material facilitates learning.
